



BYSA Hockey Uniform Policy

Jerseys

Players may only wear BYSA Hockey approved and supplied jerseys. No personal or privately purchased jerseys will be allowed. No additions or modifications will be allowed to the game jerseys without prior approval from the Executive Board.

Game jerseys will be carried on clothes hangers and in a garment bag to and from games.

Any player without the correct jersey (or a spare provided by the coach) will not be allowed to participate in games.

Maintenance of the jerseys is the responsibility of the player. A jersey damaged beyond repair during normal game conditions will be replaced at no cost by BYSA Hockey. Any jersey destroyed, soiled or ruined due to negligence or carelessness by the player or others will be replaced by the player that the jersey is assigned to.

Jerseys may not be worn outside of games without permission from the BYSA Hockey Executive Board.

After the State Tournament, BYSA Hockey jerseys can not be worn for other tournaments without approval from the Executive Board.

Any player or family that has a missing jersey or jerseys from the previous year must reimburse BYSA Hockey prior to registration for the following year.

Socks

Players may only wear BYSA Hockey approved socks (Ranger Blue as stocked by Thygesen's) during games. No alternate colors or mismatched socks will be worn. Any player without the correct socks (or spares provided by the coach) will not be allowed to participate in games.

Preferred Equipment Colors

Helmet: White (Boys) and Black (Girls)
Gloves: Red/White/Blue (or any combination), Black
Pants: Black

These are not required, but consideration during the purchase of new equipment would be appreciated.
