NOTE 1: Required for post season play for Pee Wee level and up. All clinics will have a registration process starting at 8:30am.

NOTE 2: All clinics will include an on-ice session.

NOTE 3: Register for all clinics on-line at www.usahockey.com as space can be limited. Some walk-ins are accepted.

CLINIC ATTENDANCE

Active coaches for the 2010/2011 season are those accredited at the appropriate level in 2007/2008, 2008/2009, or the 2009/2010 seasons. All others must attend the clinic(s) appropriate to the level that they will coach in the 2010/2011 season.

PLEASE ARRIVE ON TIME! On-site clinic registration and check-in starts at 8:00am with class-room presentations starting at 8:30 am.

No coach will be allowed to participate in any clinic activity unless they have completed the clinic registration form and the clinic fee has been paid in full!

USA Hockey requires that all coaches wear an approved hockey helmet on the ice for all practices and skating exercises during the clinics. All coaches attending the clinics will be required to have a helmet, gloves, skates, and a stick for the on-ice sessions. Coaches that do not bring this gear will attend the on-ice session and will be required to sit on the players' bench or the stands in the rink for all on-ice activities.

All coaches will be required to stay for the entire clinic. Anyone arriving 30 minutes late or leaves before the end of the clinic will not be issued a Coaching Card. Coaches will only be allowed to attend two (2) coaching clinics per season.

Lost Coaching Education Cards can be replaced through the State Coaching Director for a fee of \$5.00. The request for the replacement card must be made in writing with proof of achievement.
